Group Observation / Shadow Day

Kindergarten - Group Observation/Assessment: A child's success in

- kindergarten is largely determined by his or her social and emotional
- development (not just chronological age and academic preparedness).
- Yavneh's Group Observation is an engaging way for Yavneh to get to know your child in a school
 - like setting, while assessing if his or her continued development will best be supported next year in

our kindergarten classroom.



1st-8th - Shadow: Students applying for admission are invited to shadow an assigned student. What do the classrooms look like? How are the subjects taught? During the shadow day, your child will accompany a student to his/her classes, breaks and lunch. Depending on the day, he/she may attend science, art, music, PE, Hebrew, etc. and will get to participate in discussions, lessons and activities alongside students. Students will then have the opportunity to reflect on their academic experiences in all subject areas, and teachers will personally evaluate applicants.

Tuition and Fees

Tuition:

Tuition for the 2019-20 year will be established in late 2018. Below are the tuition amounts for the 2018-2019 school year. A \$500 tuition discount is offered if the deposit and enrollment contract are submitted by the specified date.



Grade	Tuition for 2018-2019
K-5	\$27,000
6-8	\$28,800

A non-refundable deposit of \$1,250 per student or \$2,000 per family (with two or more students enrolling) must accompany the signed contract. The deposit is applied to the tuition.

Families with two or more students enrolled will receive a 5% reduction on the youngest child's tuition. This discount does not apply to families receiving financial aid.

Financial Aid:

Yavneh is committed to making a Jewish Day School education accessible to every family and offers tuition assistance through a confidential process. Yavneh follows the policy of Independent School Management (ISM) using Financial Aid for School Tuition (FAST) to evaluate tuition assistance applications. This service assures both discretion and objectivity. The information provided to us by FAST is then adjusted for factors such as the cost of living in the Bay Area. Every effort is made to meet the financial needs of applicants. Because requests often exceed the funds available, it is important to apply as early as possible.
