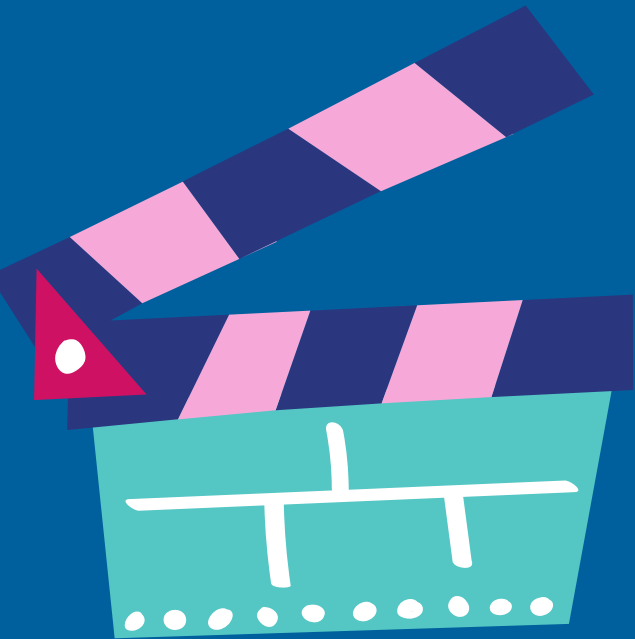

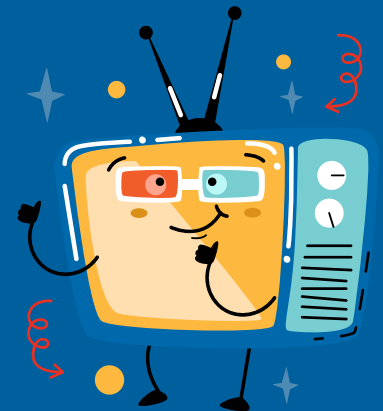
The Story Behind Cartoons- Creative Writing with EnActe Arts (Grades 5-8)

Tuesdays from 3:45-5:30 PM.

*(*Note this class covers both blocks. It's 90 minutes with a snack break from 4:30-4:45.)*

\$650 per semester- 13 classes

A typical day begins with a screening of a short animated film (3-8 minutes), then delves into story analysis and design in order to help students think critically to creatively write a story using the same logical / narrative structures. Each class ends with each student having an outline for a clearly communicated coherent narrative. This program helps students learn the invaluable skill of clear and persuasive communication from a basis of storytelling. Ultimately, students will have the structures necessary to make arguments, change minds, and impact the future. At the end of the semester each student will walk away with a portfolio of story outlines they have brainstormed during their time in the class.

Introduction to Guitar with Margaux (Grades 4-8)

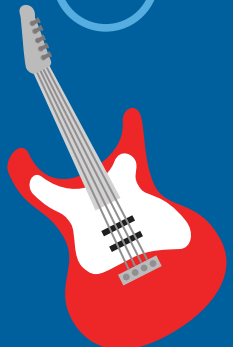

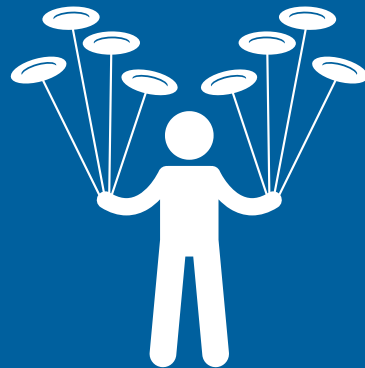


Beginner Circus Arts and Acrobatics (Grades K-2 and 3-8)

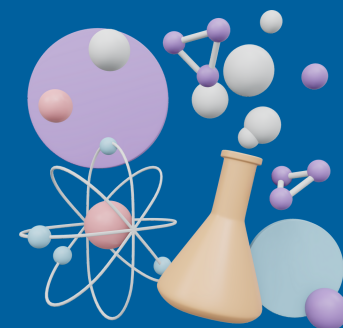
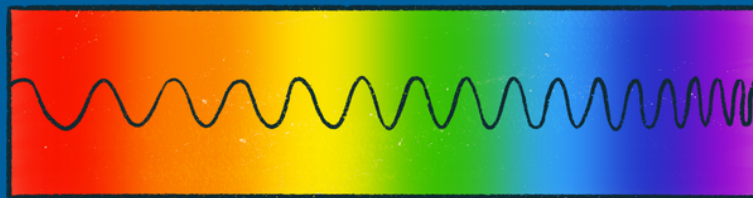
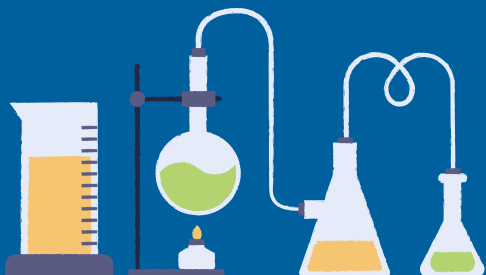




Crazy Chemworks with Mad Science

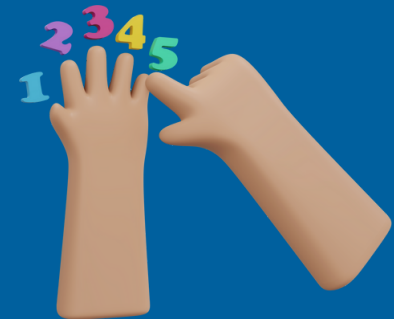
K-2 Math Enrichment with Ms. Dao
