6th Grade Overview

COMMUNITY PRACTICE - SHLICHEI TZIBBUR & BA'AL KOREH

- ★ Students become confident student leaders by spending a week being the Toran for all services (Monday, Thursday, and Friday) as well as daily Birkat Hamazon..
- ★ All MS will have an opportunity to chant Torah at least once if not twice during the year. The readings until December have already been assigned, and the rest of the year will be allocated shortly.
- ★ All of MS gathers daily to chant Birkat Hamazon together.

AM YISRAEL - EARLY ZIONISM

- ★ Students have the opportunity to learn about the beginnings of European Zionist movement through a dedicated study of Hatikvah, through the Dreyfus affair and the first Zionist Congress.
- ★ Students will explore different eras of Jewish Nationhood from the First Temple onwards, to understand the peaks and troughs of Jewish sovereignty in the land and concepts of indigeneity.
- ★ Students will also do concurrent media analyses of Israel in the News, today, to understand elements of perception and bias.

- ★ PoP Partner School Chevruta Study is a centered practice in ELA, HLA. Global Research & Jewish Studies.
- ★ Students have opportunities to study Torah, Mishnah, Midrash, and Megillah in preparation for Holidays (i.e the upcoming Teshuva Carnival!), as well as integrated into the ELA and Global Research classrooms.

AVODAH V'TZEDEK - SERVICE & JUSTICE

- ★ Students will periodically take part in different endeavors with Jewish Family Services, providing help and support for different festival preparation events (i.e. helping to prepare Rosh Hashanah meal kits.)
- ★ Students will have an opportunity to lead the school in the Tekes Yom Hazikaron (Memorial ceremony for fallen Israeli Soldiers) following intensive units in Hebrew and Jewish Studies Classes.

COMMUNITY PRACTICE - SHLICHEI TZIBBUR & BA'AL KOREH

- ★ Students become confident student leaders by spending a week being the Toran for all services (Monday, Thursday, and Friday) as well as daily Birkat Hamazon.
- ★ All MS will have an opportunity to chant Torah at least once if not twice during the year. The readings until December have already been assigned, and the rest of the year will be allocated shortly. 8th Grade students will also chant Bereisheet for the school for Simchat Torah, and learn the special cantillation for Megillat Esther.

- ★ Students will analyze, unpack, and compare the Balfour Declaration, the Declaration of Independence (of Israel) and and the latest Nation State Law to understand the political establishment and its development over the last 100 years.
- Students will also do concurrent media analyses of Israel in the News, today, to understand elements of perception and bias.
- ★ In preparation for the Israel Trip, students will will become their own tour guides. Once our itinerary is confirmed, students will create a 15 minute tour guide presentation/activity for the group.

BEIT MIDRASH - HOW WE LEARN IS WHAT WE LEARN

- ★ PoP Partner School Chevruta Study is a centered practice in ELA, HLA, Global Research & Jewish Studies.
- ★ Students have opportunities to study Torah, Mishnah, Midrash, and Megillah in preparation for Holidays, as well as integrated into the ELA and Global Research classrooms.
- ★ JCAT simulation Jewish and American historical texts to be studied in chevruta.
